Developing a plan to guide your strategy- Chris Scheid, ProAdvice

<u>Dry Times</u>: In dry times, there is a sense that we have lost control. It is not the situation that matters...but how you react now. A goal set now, for each of 'people', 'land', 'livestock' and 'business' will assist us to be more in control of dry time times.

<u>Wool futures</u>: No one is going to ring the bell at the top of the wool market. Your job as a wool grower is to grow the best wool you can and your job as a wool marketer is to secure the best price you can. Resist greed (the market will go higher). With spot wool prices at 100 percentile and 18,19 and 21 micron Spring 2019 wool prices at 85-89% of current prices...why wouldn't you look to get a piece of that?
