Soil Moisture Report-June

Great to see a decent rainfall event in June, with 30 mm being recorded at each of BIGG's weather monitoring stations on 12 June. Towards the end of the month, frosts have been more the norm, particularly at Keyneton and Koonunga with the temperature getting down to -3.6C and -2.6C respectively on 23 June.

The current soil moisture levels across the region are similar, hovering just below 50% of their capacity at Flaxman Valley, Keyneton and Koonunga. The latest information about soil moisture, growing season rainfall and what's been happening in each of the weather monitoring station paddocks can be found here.




