All aboard – Coorong Water Security Bus Trip

On Friday 26th March, BIGG will be conducting a bus trip to the Coorong where will participate in a 'water security tour'. The trip will visit several properties who are successfully harvesting rain water using lined catchments, including finding out about on-farm water technology, such as leak detection and tank water level sensors.

On the way back from the Coorong we also plan to visit a farmer who has installed a desalination plant (for stock water) to improve his livestock production.
