From the Ground Up 2023 BIGG Conference

Over 70 producers attended the highly successful 2023 BIGG Conference *From the Ground Up*. Targeted toward producers, the afternoon session provided up-to-date information on a diverse range of practical topics including:

- carbon accounting
- water security
- red meat supply chain
- banking to name a few!

- Updates on BIGG's mixed species pasture and ewe containment projects.
- Sponsor displays showcasing products and innovations relevant for today's farmers.



2023 Project Highlights

BIGG has maintained a busy schedule of farm visits and pasture walks in 2023, increasing the networking and social opportunities for our producers.

On-farm Water Strategies Bus Trip

In March, 21 attendees enjoyed a bus trip in the Lower Mid-North region to showcase various on-farm water strategies successfully implemented by farmers, including:

- Rainwater harvesting using a poly-lined catchment.
- Improving the palatability of bore water using a Hydrosmart water conditioning unit.
- Increased pasture production and groundcover through the use of rotational grazing and installation of various water infrastructure.



Water Innovations Farm Tour

Three properties in the Flaxman and Eden Valley districts were visited by 28 attendees in June to view and discuss the use of:

- A desalination plant.
- Electronic device to monitor tank water levels.
- Hydrosmart technology to manage water quality.

 Installation of bore and reticulated water infrastructure to improve farm water security.

Winter Beef Snapshot and Pregnancy Scanning Sticky Beak

The Winter Beef Snapshot evening in July provided more than 70 attendees with *'hear today - use tomorrow'* decisional support tools and economics on seasonal health and production issues.

Enthusiasm from this evening lead to an impromptu 'sticky beak' opportunity at Mt Crawford shortly after. 11 producers took the opportunity to observe ultrasound and manual pregnancy testing, and the use of a RFID wand to electronically capture an animal's identity.



2023 Project Highlights



Trigger Point workshop and Pasture Walk

The September workshop provided strategies to monitor and assess current season risks to improve decision making. 15 attended the workshop followed by lunch and pasture walks at three sites to view multi species pastures and the Croc Trough Pumping System.

Pasture Walks

Coopers agronomists and Barenbrug seed representatives conducted a guided walk of the Coopers Farm pasture plots at Mount Pleasant in October. Forty attendees where provided with the opportunity to view and discuss perennial, annual and clover pasture blends to increase pasture production and quality.

Also in October, BIGG coordinated a pasture walk for the Barossa Mid-North Dairy Discussion group and SA Drought Hub representatives. The ten attendees visited The University of Adelaide serradella trial sites at Mt Crawford and Springton and Coopers Mount Pleasant site.
