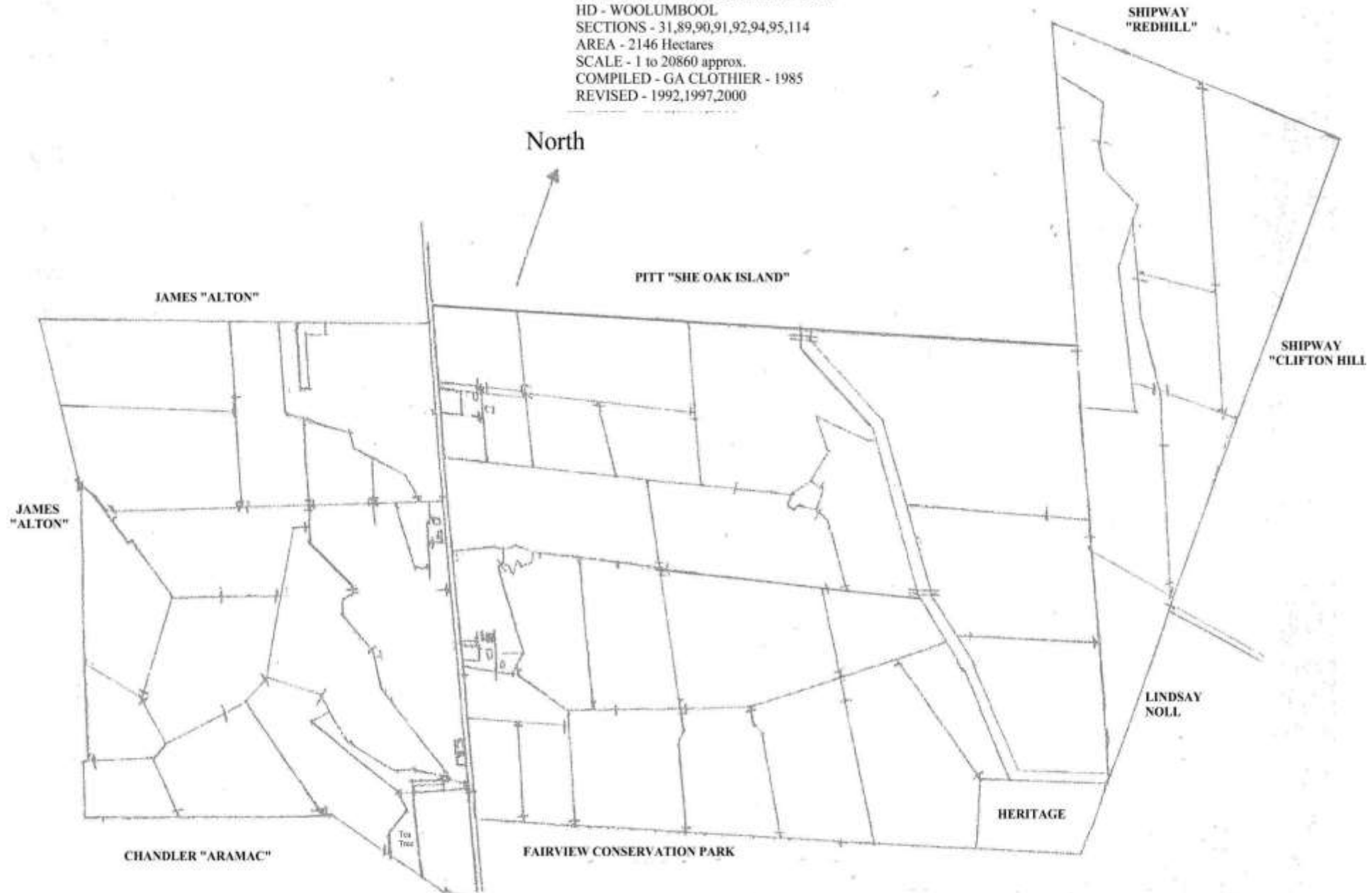

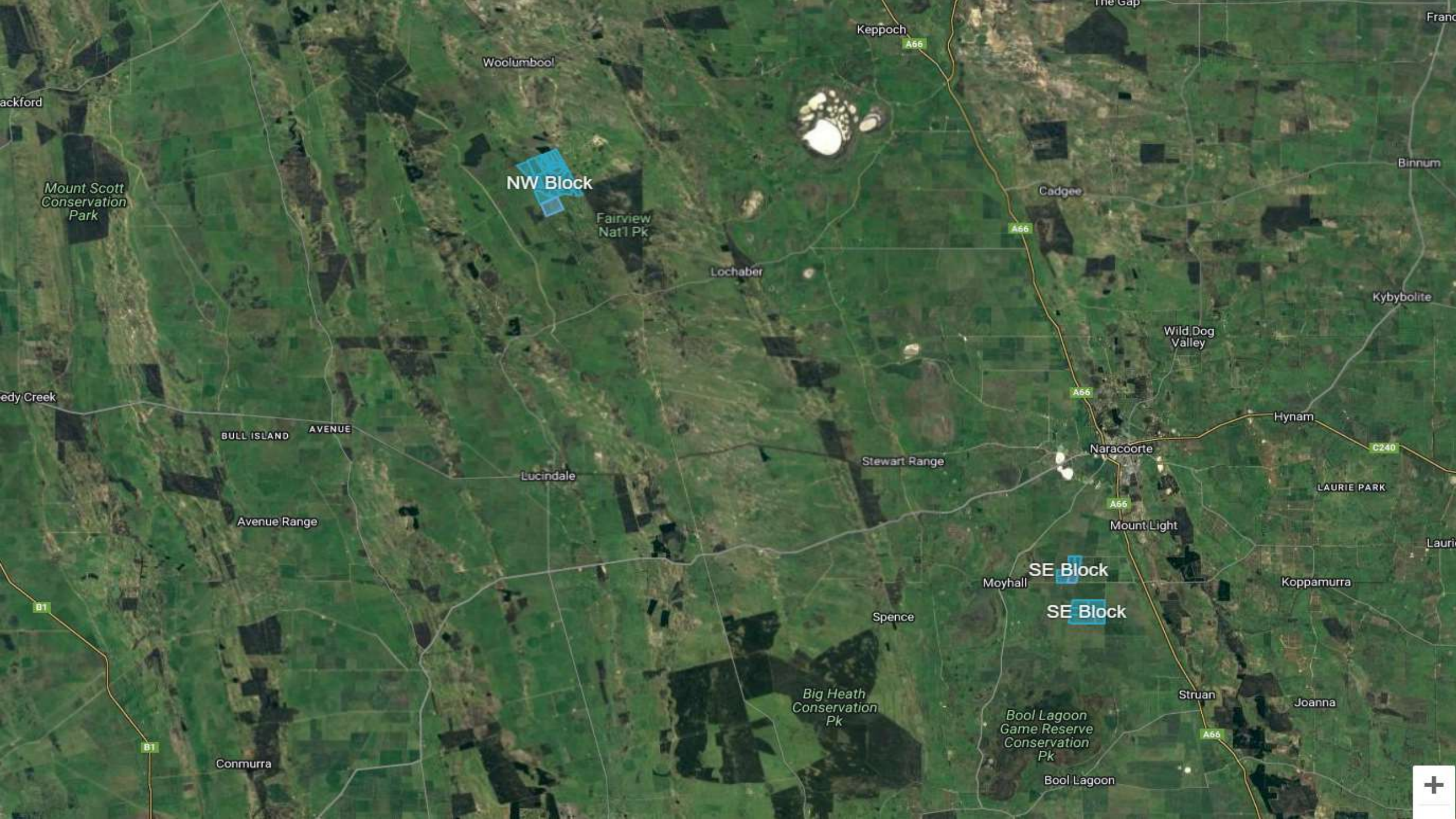

Egg Production

- 2.7 million eggs year
- 38% of the gross income goes in feed cost
- Two collectors each day approx 10 hrs total labour
- We supply two separate egg brands in Daylesford and Mt Gambier
- 520 km round trip each week to deliver eggs
- A bit like dairy
- Hens are very fickle, and it has been a steep learning curve

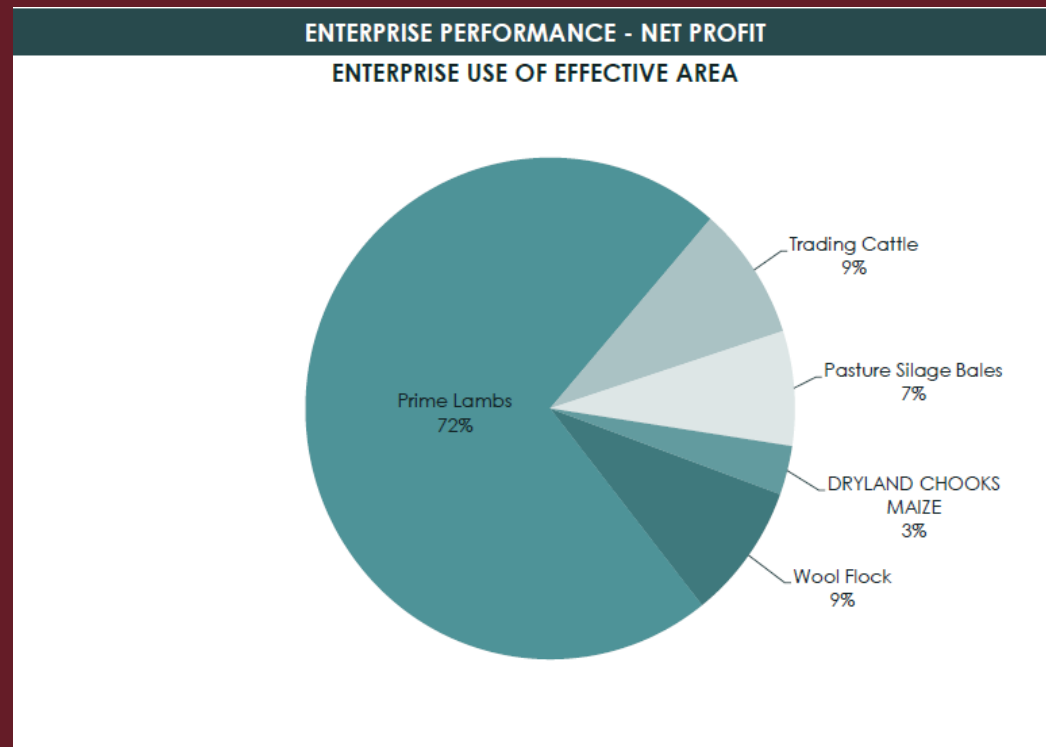

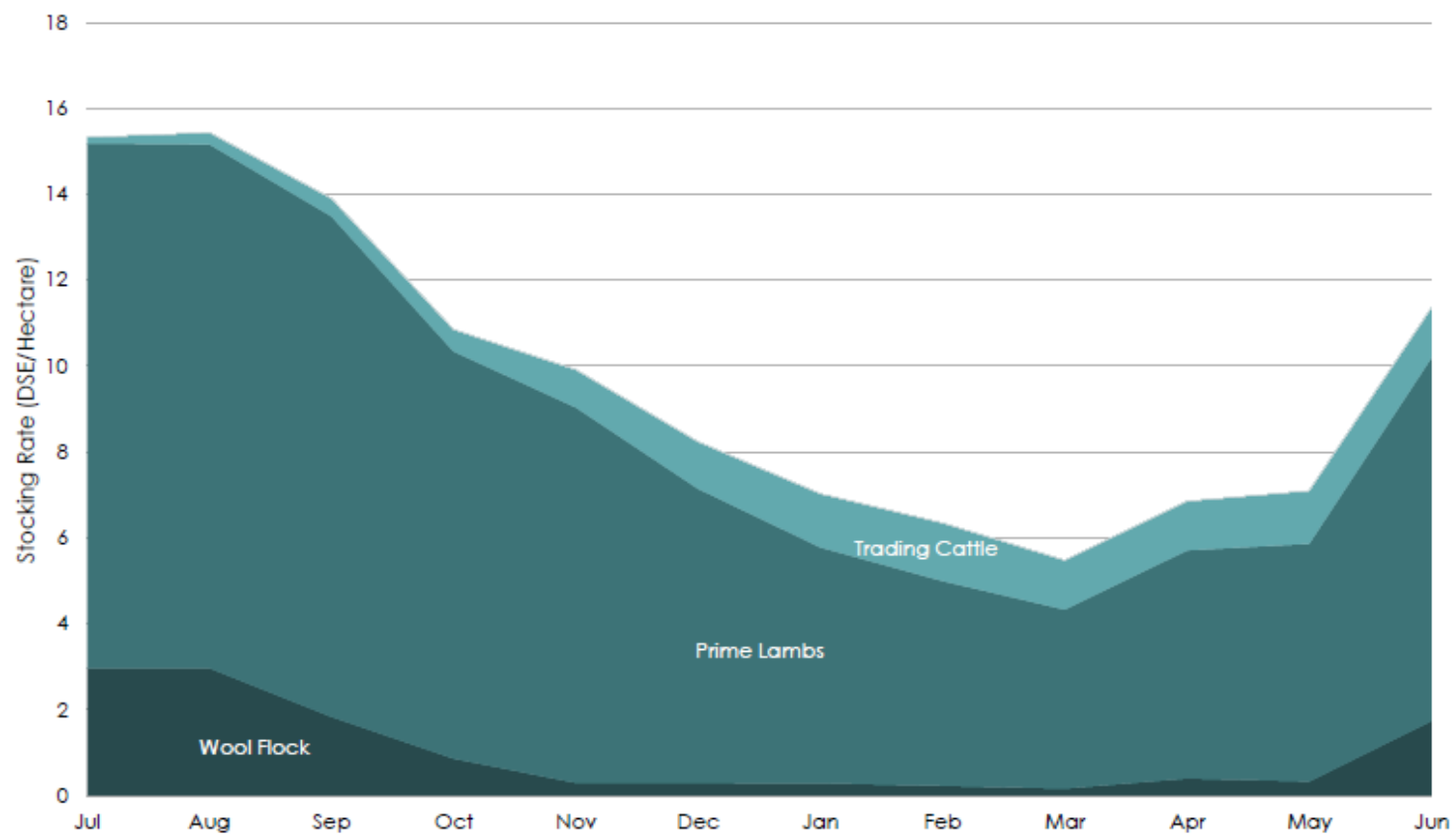
